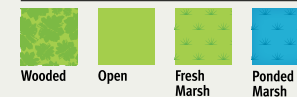

TRAIL NOTES

The trails in the northern part of the preserve are mostly narrow footpaths over uneven terrain. There are two moderate hills, but otherwise it is relatively flat. Step carefully, as many sections contain roots, vines, and other potential impediments.

The east end of the Adelaide Trail (yellow) is accessed by a neighborhood trailhead. The beginning of the trail to the powerline is a right-of-way over private property.

Please follow the signs and stay on the trail over the right-of-way.

The section under the powerline cuts through ungrounded underbrush for a short distance before turning north into the woods to join the Main Trail (red).
